The objective of the training: Throughout the course, teachers and lecturers will learn various teaching techniques and strategies, explore the role of memory and cognitive processes in learning, and gain practical insights into effective knowledge acquisition and teaching methods.

Scope of material at a glance: The training program is organized over five days, covering a range of topics related to teaching skills enhancement, such as the teaching process, various roles of teachers, types of knowledge and memory systems, and techniques for effective knowledge acquisition.

Course Overview

Day 1

Explore the teacher's role in the teaching process. Discover what students require from educators, learn how to stimulate critical thinking, explore the universality of creativity, understand how to impart common sense to young learners, and delve into the nuances of authentic communication. Also, grasp the characteristics of various roles teachers assume in the classroom.

Day 2

Uncover the significance of a good memory and explore the potential of our brains. Delve into different types of knowledge and memory systems. Examine the mechanisms behind remembering and forgetting, and understand why we often forget. Experience a simulation of the forgetting curve and explore techniques for effective knowledge acquisition (part 1). Engage in hands-on activities with provided materials

Day 3

Continue exploring techniques for effective knowledge acquisition (part 2). Learn how to implement learning techniques in teaching and consider the role of artificial intelligence. Gain insights into teaching activity and commitment. Discover strategies for organizing work that should be taught. Participate in hands-on activities with provided materials.

Day 4

Delve into the use of learning techniques in teaching with a focus on individualization of teaching. Learn how to adapt content and resources to diverse needs. Explore the intricacies of online teaching, including features of effective presentations and strategies to prevent cognitive overload. Engage in hands-on activities with provided materials.

Day 5

When to apply knowledge acquisition techniques - the workshop's key points. Participant presentations showcasing good practices.
